### How will the course benefit me?

This course will allow you to explore art in motion. You will expand your scope of creativity by producing movement to your own creations through a 2-dimensional software.

# **Entry Requirements**

No previous knowledge is required for this course, we will start from the beginning.

### What will I learn?

You will learn how to introduce motion to your drawings by using Adobe Animate software which has got a huge range of tools that will produce movement in a very easy and fun way. You will learn how to draw a character, for example, and make it walk, run, blink, etc..

#### How will the course be delivered?

The course is structured in sessions of two hours per day. We will start with basic movement of shape and location in a progressive way, so throughout the course you will increase your skills by adding new tools in every session. You will work with a PC and the lastest version of the Adobe Suit Collection.

### How is this course assessed?

We will assess your progress via individual feedback from the tutor on the basis of observation. We will also have group feedback via screening of works.

# **Progression or Employment pathways**

The course programme is structured in a way that your learning will be progressively increasing so you can step

into a high level (such as After Effects, for example).

The only item you need for this course is a pair of headphones for the lessons where we add sound.
