



Art - Woodland Scenes in Watercolour

What will I learn?

This 4-week course is an introduction to painting in watercolour. Learners will practise the basic techniques of watercolour and also improve their drawing skills. Basic watercolour techniques will be taught, such as washes, glazes and "wet-on-wet", with projects that could include woodland wildlife, landscape and natural still-life. Colour-mixing will be included as it adds to the skill base of this course.

Entry Requirements

This course is NOT suitable for complete beginners. It is aimed at those who have enthusiasm for the subject matter and maybe a small amount of experience, but beginners are welcome. Learners will be building on their confidence and skill base and extending their ideas and knowledge.

Assessment / Exam

You will receive regular verbal feedback from your tutor, who will assess you continually and informally. An Individual Learning Plan will help you monitor your progress and reach your targets.

Career Opportunities

To other art courses within the Institute. Some learners move on to the 15-week watercolour course or a foundation course, or GCSE art. Some learners may want to return to this course as it is a popular theme.
